


To see if the Precinct will vote to choose the following Precinct officers: Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, and Deputy Treasurer for one (1) year terms and a Commissioner for a three (3) year term.

Article 02 Expand the purpose of Precinct

To see if the Precinct will vote, pursuant to RSA 52:6, to expand the purposes of the Precinct to include (a) the construction, operation and maintenance of drains and common sewers and (b) the construction, operation and maintenance of sewage and waste treatment plants, as such purposes are permitted under RSA 52:1, to enable the Precinct to provide sewer service within the Precinct and franchise areas, if approved by the Public Utilities Commission.

(The Board of Commissioners recommends this expansion of the Precinct purposes.)

Article 03 Expand the purpose of Precinct to include wastewat

If Article 2 passes, to see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate an amount up to the sum of Forty One Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand and No/100ths Dollars (\$41,950,000.00) for capital expenditures to provide a four-phased sewer service installation throughout the Precinct and in connection therewith to authorize the issuance Precinct to include wastewater of bonds or notes of the Precinct under and in compliance with the provisions of the New Hampshire Municipal Finance Act (RSA Chapter 33:1 et seq, as amended) and all other applicable statutory authority, including without limitation governor and council approval pursuant to RSA 33:5-b and RSA 33:5-c, to authorize the Board of Commissioners to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes, to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms and conditions thereof, and to pass any other vote relative thereto, and further to authorize the Board of Commissioners to apply for, accept and expend such additional sums and grants as may become available from federal, state or other sources. Overall bonding authority will not lapse until the project is completed.

(The Board of Commissioners recommends this appropriation.)
(2/3 Ballot Vote Required.)
(Polls shall remain open and ballots shall be accepted by the moderator for a period of not less than one hour following the completion of discussion on said Article 3.)

Article 04 Capital expenditures for the purpose of planning

If Article 3 fails, to see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate an amount up to the sum of One Hundred Thousand and No/100ths Dollars (\$100,000.00) for capital expenditures for the purpose of planning relative to public facilities and in connection therewith to authorize the issuance of bonds or notes of the Precinct under and in compliance with the provisions of the New Hampshire Municipal Finance Act (RSA Chapter 33:1 et seq, as amended) and all other applicable statutory authority, to authorize the Board of Commissioners to issue and negotiate such bonds or



notes, to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms and conditions thereof, and to pass any other vote relative thereto, and further to authorize the Board of Commissioners to apply for, accept and expend such additional sums and grants as may become available from federal, state or other sources. Overall bonding authority will not lapse until the project is completed.

(The Board of Commissioners recommends this appropriation.)

Article 05 General Operations (Executive & Admin)

To see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$230,872.45) for general government operations for the ensuing year to include: executive, office, administration, office expenses, legal and professional services, insurance and miscellaneous general government expenses.

Article 06 Water Distribution and Treatment

To see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$423,738.36) for water distribution and treatment for the ensuing year to include: general operations, electricity, telecommunications, treatment chemicals, supplies, tools, propane, maintenance, repair and materials.
